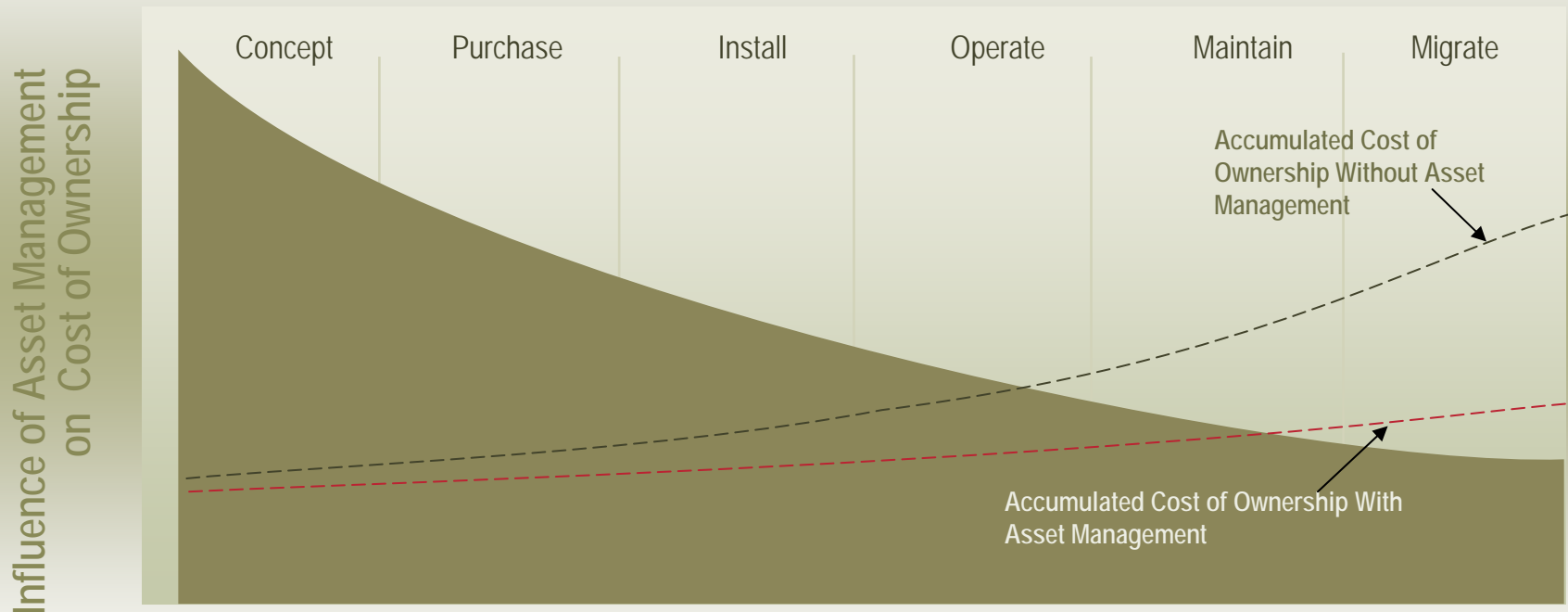
Automation Asset Management: Rockwell Automation Approach

- A collaborative approach that optimizes asset value by using software, technology platforms, and people to improve decision making around life cycle costs



Automation Asset Management: Early Implementation Maximizes Return

- An asset management program has the most influence on reducing the cost of ownership when implemented early in the system life cycle



Automation Asset Management: Common Plant Objectives

We need to insure our operation is running the way it was designed to run or better!

disaster recovery

improve maintenance staff effectiveness

product safety & quality

employee safety

regulatory scrutiny

reducing commissioning time & cost

monitor & protect assets

reduce risk to production

excessive unplanned downtime

improved site security



Automation Asset Management: Common Plant Conversations

Minor changes to stay operational tends to cause major problems later.

It seems like some of our maintenance practices may be unnecessary.

We cannot manage every version well and we have made mistakes.

We lost the comments to another program.

We are not sure we have every asset's configuration program.

If only we could get information from our critical devices so we would know if something is out of spec.

We might have downloaded the wrong program to the wrong machine.

It's running so it's probably fine.

We think we lost a version of the program for that machine.

Our security risk profile, what is that?

The X^\$&^%()& machine is down! Again!

A line operator opened a controller's editor and altered a variable to reduce the amount of time the line spent in a certain function so that his line would produce more product during that shift.

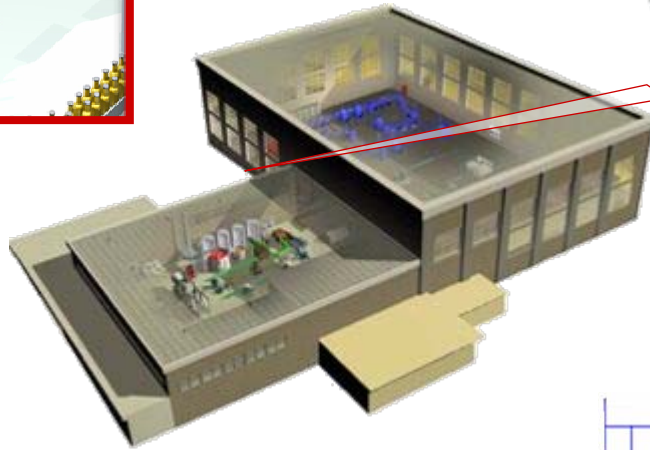
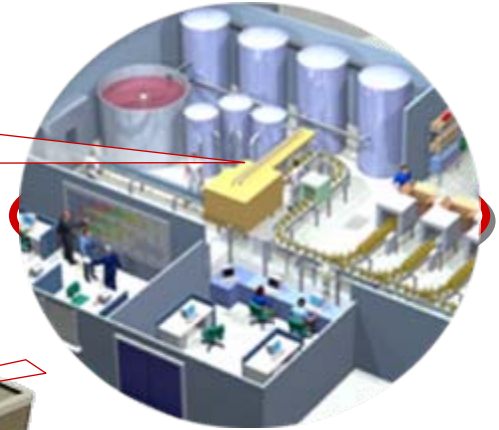
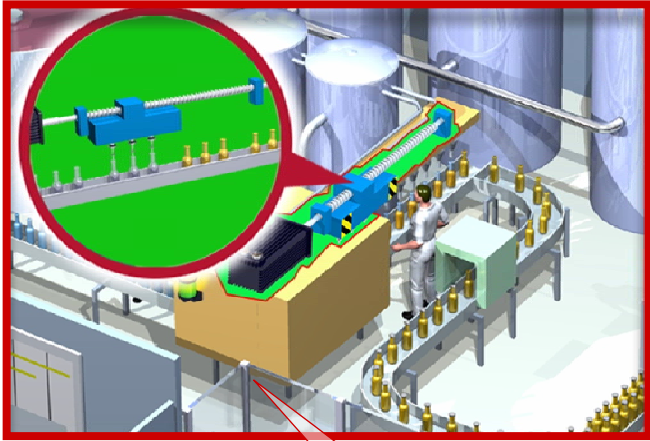
A problem with product quality was caught many weeks later that resulted in a recall of a lot of product.

A manual method was already in place!

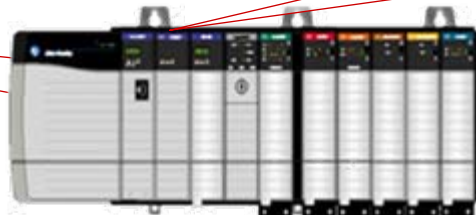
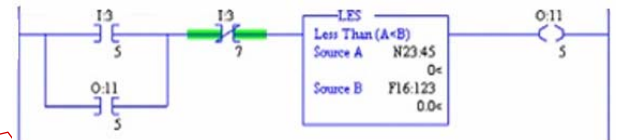


Automation Asset Management: Automation Assets Influence on Production

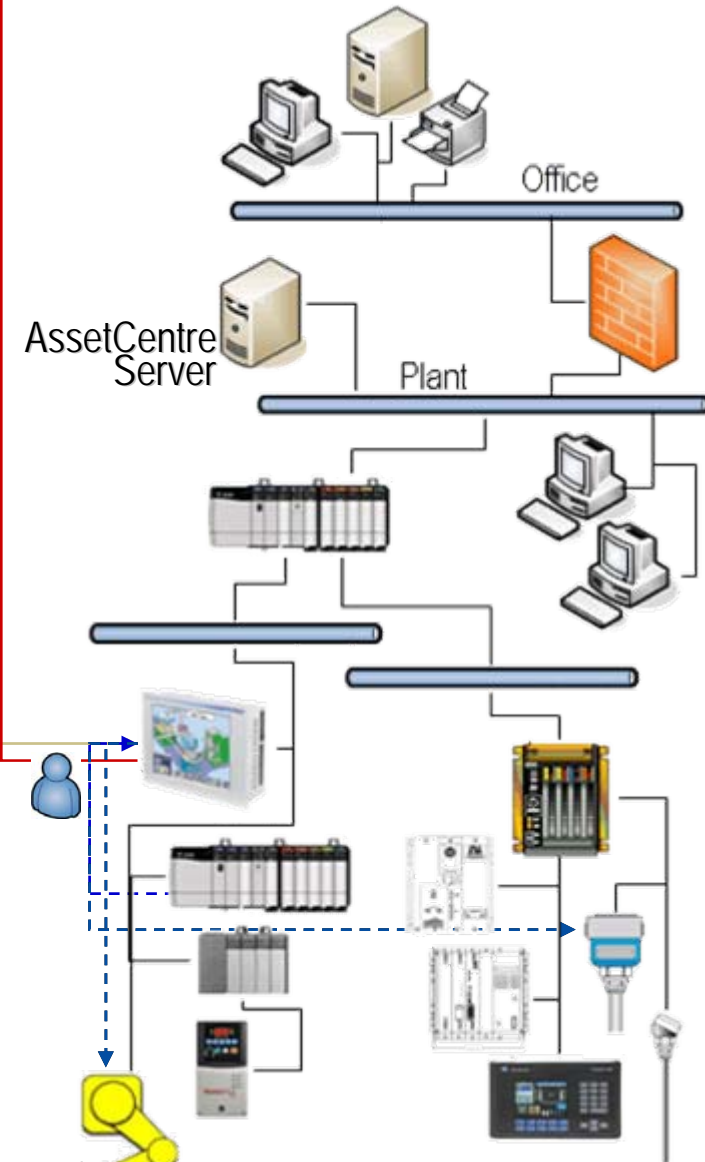
- Centralized Database 

- Database, Microsoft SQL Server, is configured automatically as part of the system install
- **Central repository for Source Control, Audit and Event information**
- **Secure** environment for information and source control
 - Cannot lose files or accidentally delete them
 - Large storage capability
 - Replication capability



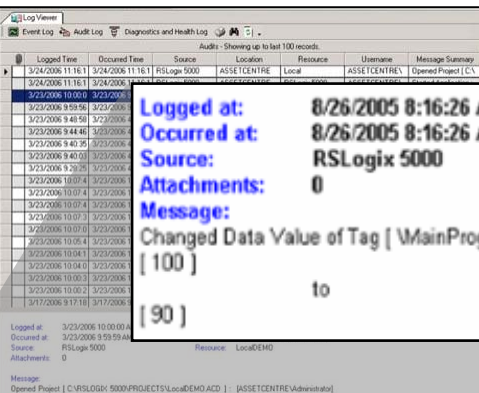
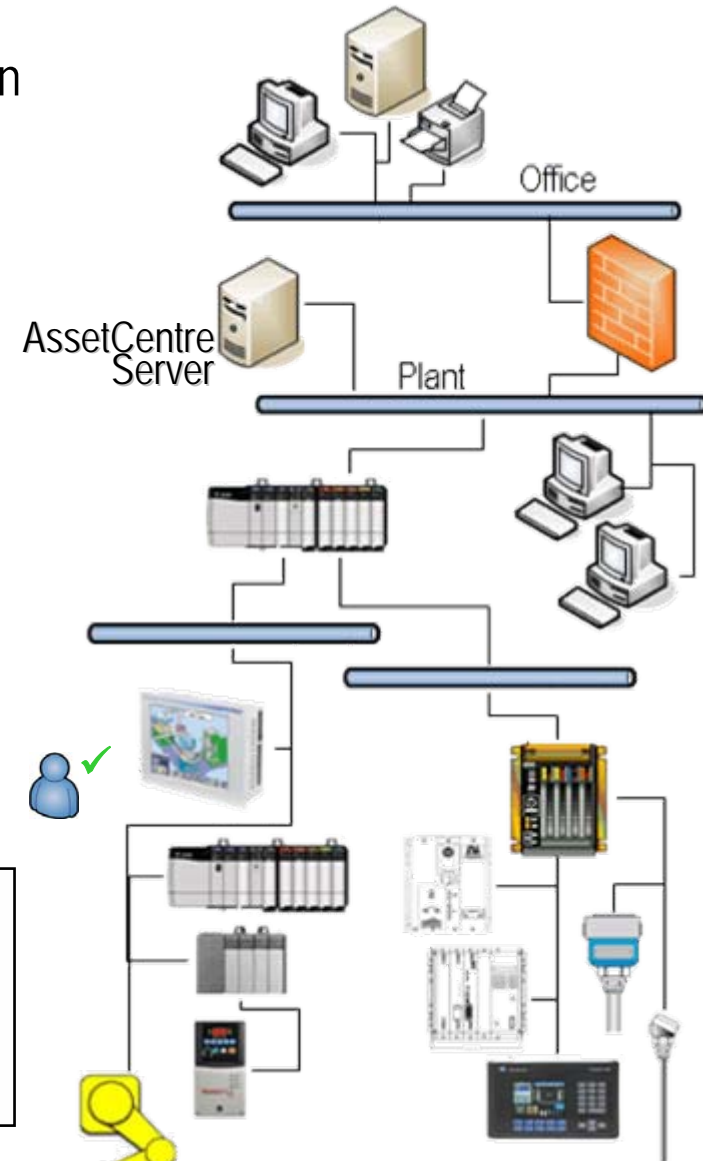

- Source Control  v41   v42
 - Secure repository utilizes the database
 - Stores any files, configurations, programs, SOPs, CAD, and more
 - Automatic version control insures proper file management
 - Maintains master file
 - File locking prevents multiple users from changing same file
 - Pinning allows previous version to be identified as master version



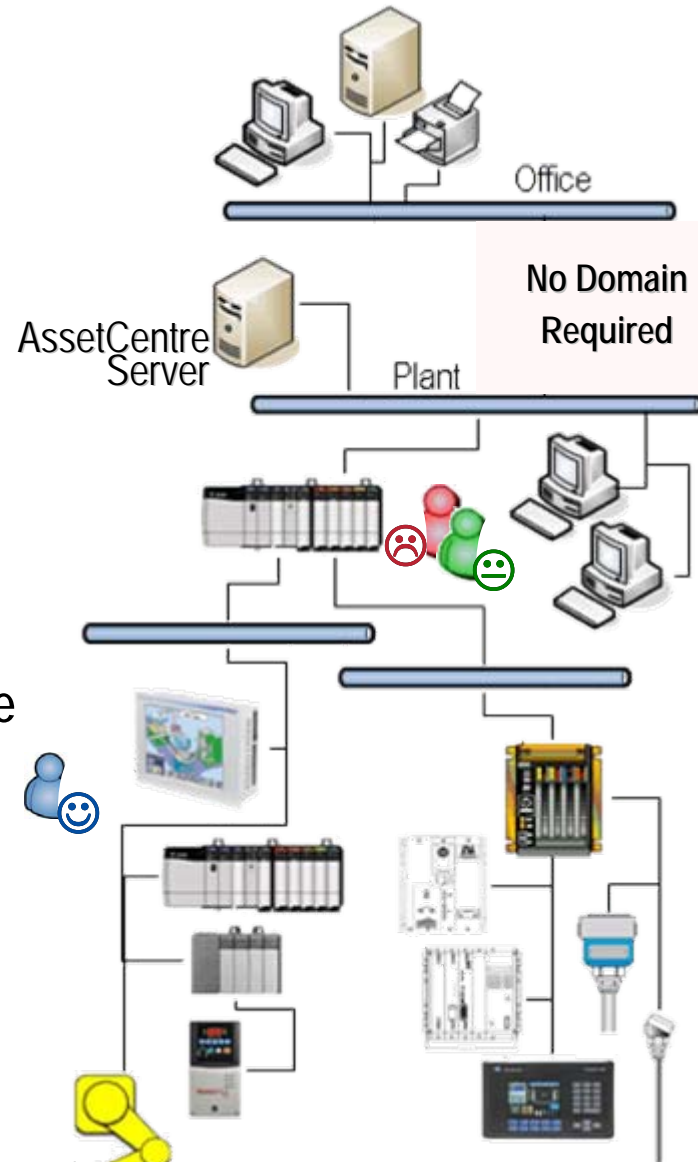

- Audits ✓
 - Serves as a central repository for Audit information in real-time from FactoryTalk applications
 - Captures Audit messages generated by user actions

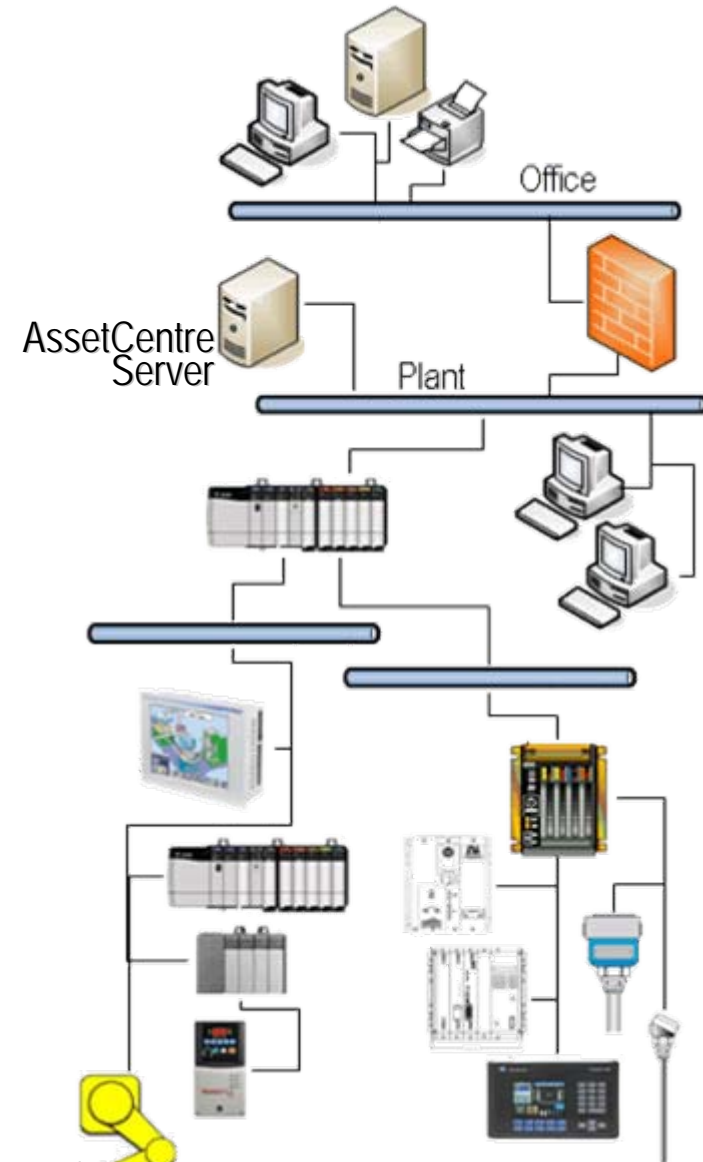

 - Scheduling, reporting, and tracking

 - Supports E-signatures
 - Paperless record keeping
 - Certificate capable
 - Incorporates traceability and security features
 - Maintains record histories such as last calibrated, “as left, as found”



FactoryTalk AssetCentre - Product Preview: Customer Benefits

- Automatic version control on the masters and allows copies so we do not lose code or comments again
 - Stores many types of files including documents, CAD drawings, controller programs, network and instrument configurations, and more
- Automatically uploads and compares files, robots, controllers and drive configurations to the master files
 - When differences are found, it generates a report and notifies the appropriate person in e-mail,
 - It can store it in Source Control as a new version and notify us also
- Operators can only view code – changes are not allowed
- Reports are created automatically now at the end of each shift
- Real-time audit messages from editors including the user, connected to which device, using which editor, on which computer and what exact changes were made
 - This would have recorded the tag the operator changed
- Centrally manage distributed process device configuration through FDT/DTM technology
- Calibration management – ensures quality of process data by managing instrument calibration workflow requirements and history
- Centrally manage process device configurations



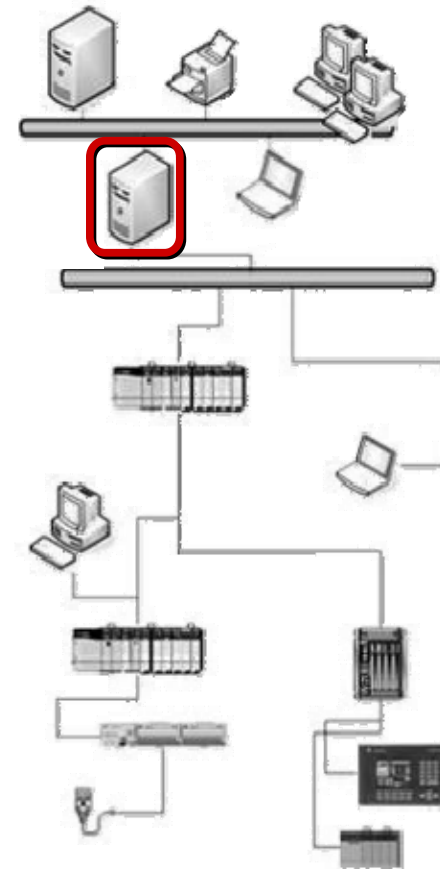

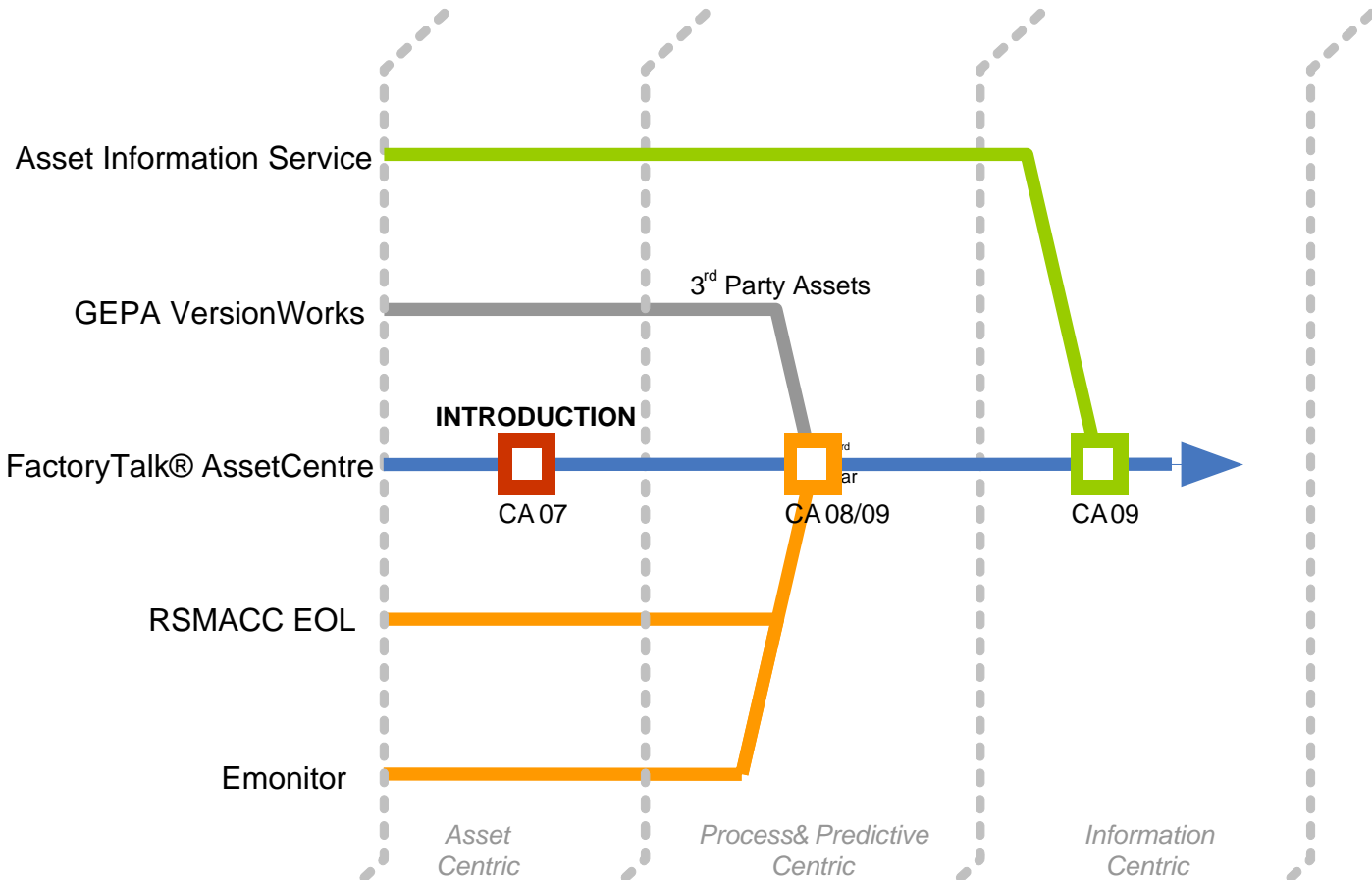
